In addition to the full list of Rules enclosed, the Tournament Committee would like to draw your attention to the following:

1. Entries On-Line or download the entry form on ITBA website, by hand to Barbara Sloan, Mark Delany ALSAA Bowl or by **E-Mail** to secretary.executive@tenpinbowling.ie Postal or telephone entries will **NOT** be accepted.
2. Entries received after the 13th of February 2024 closing date may not be included in the Open Draw – their lane assignments will be allocated by the Tournament Committee.
3. It is imperative that **EVERY** bowler intending to play in **ANY** event must fill in a separate Entry Form. It is not enough to be named on somebody else's entry form.
4. The enclosed Tournament Schedule **is provisional**. Based upon the number of entries received, the Tournament Committee will publish the times for each event (and E-Mail to bowlers with the Championships Booklet). We also reserve the right to:
 - ❖ Add or delete squads where necessary and
 - ❖ Amalgamate Men's and Ladies squads for some events.
 - ❖ At its sole discretion, add bowler(s) to any event to fill teams/squads.
5. **All Events:**
 - ❖ The top 6 Men and top 4 Ladies will bowl nine games in the All Events.
 - ❖ Both the Men's and Ladies winners of the All Events will represent Ireland in the **European Champions of Champions, in Bratislava, Slovakia, 21st – 28th Oct 2024**, receiving **€1,000 each** towards entry fees and costs, should they take-up the invitation to represent Ireland at this prestigious tournament.
 - ❖ **NDP Academy Sponsors prize(s) of €100 for each new Championship record.**
6. To PLAY in this year's Championships bowlers **MUST** wear a bowling shirt in each event, including Mixed Doubles, with their name (**First Name and Surname**) clearly printed or embroidered on the back.
7. Decisions made by the Joint Tournament Managers, during the Championships will be binding on all parties.
8. To assist in the smooth running of the Championships no coaching is allowed during bowling and Lane Marshalls will be appointed to ensure events and lane changes run as scheduled.
9. Tournament Committee is not responsible for forming teams. Following will apply:
 - ❖ Gaps in teams (i.e. doubles/trios/team event) will be filled, where possible, by amalgamation with other incomplete teams, after the 13th of Feb 2024 entry closing date.
 - ❖ Once these teams are published **NO CHANGES WILL BE PERMITTED.**
