Anti-Doping Control Officer Communication

Further to the Anti-Doping up-date provided at our AGM in April 2015, The Irish Sports Council (ISC) have now launched its latest initiative of an On-Line Reporting Form

The ISC Intelligence programme is a vital part of the Anti-Doping programme and seeks to collect any information that will assist in the detection, deterrence, enforcement or prevention of an Anti-Doping Rule Violation (ADRV).

ADRVs include use and attempted use of prohibited substances in sport, but also extend to administration of a prohibited substance, possession and trafficking in prohibited substances.

The ISC requests you to complete its anonymous online submission form if you have any specific information or concern about possible doping in sport. No matter how small you think your concerns are, it wants to hear from you. All information passed on to the ISC Anti-Doping Unit will be dealt with in strict confidence.

Please contact ISC Anti-Doping Unit if you:

- Have witnessed doping in sport.
- Have been offered banned substances.
- Suspect someone might be doping.
- Suspect someone might be supplying banned substances to athletes.
- Are concerned about the behaviour or practises of an athlete, coach or any support personnel.

Let's continue to keep Irish Tenpin Bowling drug free and support the ISC Anti-Doping Unit by using this safe and secure way of reporting.
