



Record-Breaking Larkin dominates at 50th ITBA National Championships

Amanda Larkin became the first player ever to win gold in every National Championship event as she won six gold medals in this year's 50th anniversary of the tournament.

Larkin took gold in the Mixed Doubles, Singles, Doubles, Trios, Team and All Events on her way to a dominant 400-pin victory and first National title.

As a result of her victory, Larkin will now represent Ireland at this year's European Champions Cup, an annual event which features all National Champions from across the continent in a week-long event. This year's tournament will be held in San Marino between the 19th and 26th October.

Larkin has shown stunning form so far in 2015, with her first National title coming just over a month after her incredible 4th place finish in the Irish Open, a European Bowling Tour event featuring some of the best players in European and World bowling. The Tallaght bowler won the Ladies division in the tournament as well, beating off a host of former Ladies champions.

2015 already looks like being Larkin's year, and hopefully will come to a conclusion with a positive European Champions Cup for the Irish champion.
