The Irish Tenpin Bowling Association's 2023 AGM was held on Tuesday 25th April 2023 Hybrid (ZOOM and in person)

In summary, the eight-member Executive comprised of 5 ladies (62.5%) and 3 men (37.5%), thus meeting the 37.5% gender balance threshold in the ITBA Constitution and Sport Ireland's 40% threshold to qualify for receipt of annual Core Grants.

- The Grant awarded from Sport Ireland for 2024 is €55,000. In January 2024, a Bonus Grant of €8000 was paid for 2023. In Feb 2024, we were advised of an €8,000 increase in Core Grant to €55,000.

Executive and Sub-committee Meetings.

Meetings of Executive Committee and Sub-committees are held 2nd Tuesday of every month.

A number of extra meetings were held with Executive and Sub-committees and ITBA members on a required basis.

A 32 County NGB Working Group has been established in January 2024 with two members from ITBA, two members from NITBF and one member to represent both Executives.

The first meeting was held in January 2024 and established a comprehensive list of goals and milestones. Three information sessions have been held for ITBA members and a list of FAQ's have been circulated. A motion for this year's AGM has been proposed by the ITBA Executive to vote on whether to amalgamate the two organisations to build a better future for Tenpin Bowling in Ireland.

The ITBA Executive is strongly recommending a "YES" vote to create a 32 County NGB with an EGM to be held later this year to approve all necessary documentation including a new 32 County NGB Constitution.

Governance & Compliance

(a) Policies & Procedures:

- (b) Policies & Procedures continue to be reviewed annually and updated as needed. In September 2203, we adopted and circulated with the annual Membership Renewal the new Sport Ireland Guidelines for an improved ITBA General Code of Conduct.
- (c) **Risk Management:** On-going risk management is undertaken with the benefit of our Code of Governance templates. A full risk review management assessment will be undertaken in 2024.
- (d) **Gender Equality:** Under the Government's National Sports Policy and the latest Sports Ireland Action Plan, the current target is for a minimum of 40% representation of each gender on the Executive by end of 2023. Currently, the ITBA have a gender balance of 62.5% women and % at Executive level, thus meeting Sport Ireland's requirements for receipt of annual Core Grants.
- (e) Volunteers I would like to take this opportunity to thank all our volunteers Executive, Subcommittees, Team Managers, Chaperones, Coaches, Scorekeepers, Tournament Managers, and all those who regularly assist in ensuring the Association continues to develop for the benefit of all bowlers and members.

AGM 2024 on 23rd April 2024:

Under the Constitution, the AGM 2024 will need to elect the following Executive members, with at least three members from each gender:

- 1. Chair
- 2. Secretary
- 3. Treasurer
- 4. Member & Vice-President
- 5. Member
- 6. Member who will also be member of Junior Sub-committee
- 7. Member who will also be member of Senior Sub-committee
- 8. Member who will also be member of Team Ireland Sub-committee

To continue to meet Sport Ireland Gender Balance requirements, we need to elect an eight-person Executive, composed of at least 4 members of each gender and with each Group Sub-committee – Juniors, Seniors and Team Ireland to have one Executive member.

The current p of the Executive is designed to ensure:

- More members available to cover all the various duties required of the Executive.
- Current 40% Governance Code minimum representation for both genders being met.
- Improved representation for membership groups Junior, Seniors, and Team Ireland

Tenpin Bowling Council of Ireland (TBCI)

No meeting was held with Tenpin Bowling Council of Ireland (TBCI). A meeting will be scheduled by the new Execuitve with TBCI.by the end June 2024.

Winter initiative



Sport Ireland encouraged all NGBs to run a winter initiative to promote return to sport. As part of this the ITBA ran (jointly with ALTBC/ALSAA) The Dom Barrett Showcase and launched the pilot Blanchardstown Junior Club aimed at promoting the sport and acquiring new members. It was decided to continue to launch new clubs targeting new members and try to increase participation in the sport across other bowling centres.

Web Design and Development

Although the ITBA website www.tenpinbowling.ie and its sister site www.bowlingforall.ie continues to be updated, a full revamp of the sites is under development and is well advanced.

58th National Scratch Championships

In February, the 58th National Championships took place in ALSAA Bowl. It was held over one weekend. 46 bowlers participated this year.

The National Champions of 2024 are **Hannah Masterson** & **Taylor Forde Williams**, both of whom have been invited to represent Ireland at the European Champions Cup, in Bratislava, Slovakia 21 – 28th Oct 2024,

Hannah Masterson - In recognition of her outstanding achievement of winning Masters Silver at the European Youth Championships, Helsinki, Finland 25th to 31st March 2024.

The Girls Junior Team Hannah Masterson, Anna Lawlor, Laura Grant, and Ciara Lawlor who won a Team Bronze at the European Youth Championships, Helsinki, Finland in March 2024. New National Record across all 'Team' categories. It should be noted that they are the first medal winning team across all age groups men or women, to have a 'Team average' of over 200 (204.005) since the foundation of the ITBA.
