Check-in: 09:30am Bowling at: 10:00am (sharp)

Bowlers will play 6 Games moving one pair of lanes to the right after each game

Entry Fee: €25 or £20 if paid by Card

Oil Pattern: **Big Ben (44ft)** – See Below

To be eligible to bowl in the monthly junior tournaments, all bowlers <u>must be current junior members of the ITBA or</u> <u>NITBF</u>.

How to enter: Applications will be accepted through email only. Applications will be accepted until 8pm on Thursday, 5th December 2024. Applications must be sent to juniors@tenpinbowling.ie and include the full name of your child or children taking part and the relevant age group they are competing in (Under 16 or Under 19).

International Tournament Qualification

Junior Triple Crown 2025 ("JTC"): Ranking points will be awarded, subject to the junior eligibility criteria, based on the final position of each bowler within their designated age category. The current age categories for JTC are 'Age 15 & Under' and 'Age 18 & Under'.

European Youth Championships 2025 ("EYC"): Tournament averages will be used to determine eligibility for EYC panel selection. Qualifying averages are: Boys – 180 Average and Girls – 170 Average. Qualifying age group 'Under 18'.

As these events are ranking tournaments, the following dress code and rules apply:

• Girls must wear plain-coloured skorts or skirts or black slacks / trousers or sport leggings. Length of skorts / skirts must confirm with National Ranking Tour Rules & Regulations and Selection Criteria 2024-2025.

- Boys must wear plain-black slacks / trousers.
- Shorts, leggings, sleeveless tops, tee shirts and V-neck tee shirts are amongst the clothing items not permitted.
- Bowlers are no longer required to have their name printed or embroidered on the back of their bowling shirt. Bowlers must wear a polo-shirt, collared shirt or sports top (new style bowling shirts with large rounded collar) throughout the tournament including finals.
- All bowlers must check-in before going on the lanes.
- Mobile phones are not permitted once you register for tournaments or training and must be switched off during play.
- The use of earphones, unless medically prescribed, is not permitted during training sessions or Junior tournaments.

• All bowlers are expected to comply with the members Code of Ethics, Social Media Policy and Anti-doping rules – all of which are available online – www.tenpinbowling.ie

All bowler must comply with Irish Anti-Doping Rules and with the World Anti-Doping Code. (WADA 2021 code)

Failure to comply with the Dress Code and/or Rules may result in disqualification, loss of ranking points and loss of eligibility for selection. Serious breaches of the Code of Ethics or Social Media Policy may result in loss of eligibility for selection and withdrawal of ITBA membership.
