#### **Tournament Rules**

- 1. The Tournament is sanctioned by the ITBA and the ITBA/EBF general playing, and tournament rules will apply. For more information on EBF championship rules see, <a href="http://etbf.eu/wp-content/uploads/ORG-Rules.pdf">http://etbf.eu/wp-content/uploads/ORG-Rules.pdf</a>
- 2. To be eligible to bowl in the Senior Touring League all bowlers must be aged 49 or older and be a current member of the ITBA and must be prepared to produce their membership card when registering to bowl.
- 3. Athlete must wear a bowling shirt whether it be a collared polo, new style of bowling shirt with large, rounded collar, or dye sublimated, the definition of this is a shirt directly affiliated within the Tenpin Bowling Industry. The bowling shirt must not contain any logos which compromise the integrity of the ITBA.
- 4. Note: it is no longer a requirement for bowlers to have their full name or surname clearly visible in either print or embroidery on the back of a collared shirt or sports shirt. However, if you wish, you can continue to wear your bowling shirts with your name embroidered on the back.
- 5. Participants may wear plain-coloured dress slacks, plain coloured tracksuit bottoms, sports leggings, tailored golf shorts, skirts or skorts. Length of skirt, skorts or shorts must be below the participant's fingertips when they are standing, and their arms are hanging down at their side. Length of skirt, skorts, and shorts MUST be long enough to not see your bottom area (even if covered by under shorts) at any time, standing or bent over.
- 6. It is the bowlers' responsibility to ensure that their bowling balls conform to the latest 'United States Bowling Congress Approved Bowling Ball List' specifications for weight, balance, and hardness.
- 7. All bowling balls must be registered prior to the start of the Tournament maximum of 10 balls. No replacements or additions will be allowed once the first event has started, and no modifications of a bowling ball shall be permitted apart from the altering of the surface as described below. In very special circumstances the Championship Committee may allow a replacement of a registered bowling ball once the first event has started.
- 8. Random checks of the identity of the bowling balls used in competition will be performed during the squads at the discretion of the Championship Committee.
- 9. Adjusting of the surface of the bowling ball by means of scrub sponges, scoring pads, and polish that are on the list of approved products may be done only during any practice session and between any block of games, as well as between semifinals and finals of an event, provided it is done outside of the athletes' area.
- 10. Altering the surface of the bowling ball by means of bonded or coated abrasives may only be done in a designated area (before the approach area) and only during any practice session, and between any block of games, as well as between semi-finals and finals of an event.
- 11. Registration will close 10 minutes before bowling is due to commence, and practice will start. Bowlers arriving late will not be allowed to bowl and cannot be moved to another squad.
- 12. A provisional ball shall be rolled in the case of any dispute which cannot be resolved immediately.
- 13. Any complaint must be made in writing to the Tournament Committee within 30 minutes of the end of the squad in which the issue in question occurred. Decisions made by the Joint Tournament Committee during the Championships will be binding on all parties
- 14. The Tournament Committee will be Barbara Sloan (Tournament Manager), Áine Lebioda, Kevin Horton, Ray Bergin, Paul McCauley, Mark Higson, Stephen Ekermans, and Pat Holmes and their decision on all matters will be final.
- 15. Bowlers must comply with Sport Ireland anti-doping rules in line with the World Anti-Doping Policy and will not be permitted to smoke or consume alcohol during any of the bowling events.
- 16. Coaching is not permitted during tournament play.
- 17. Bowlers are reminded that they must be ready to bowl when it is their turn, one lane courtesy being observed on either side.
- 18. Mobile phones must be switched to silent mode during play.
- 19. This Tournament is a Scratch and Handicap event, and medals will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> places in both Scratch and Handicap sections.
- 20. The Scratch medal winners will be awarded first, based on scratch scores, and the Handicap medals will be awarded from the remaining Bowlers/Teams based on handicap scores.
- 21. A scratch score will win a medal in the handicap section if that bowler/team score is higher than one that includes a handicap.
- 22. High Game medals (man and woman) will be awarded for highest game (including Mixed Doubles).
- 23. The top male and female bowler on handicap score, who do not qualify for the scratch Masters, will hold the Bernard Groves Memorial trophies for one year.
- 24. In the event of a tied situation at any stage in the Championships, highest last game (scratch) will prevail.

- 25. The winner of the ladies' scratch singles will hold the Elspeth Gailey Memorial trophy for one year and the winner of the men's scratch singles will hold the Larry O'Leary Memorial trophy for one year.
- 26. Ranking Points will be awarded based on current gold points for Ladies and Men, for scratch pinfall from the Singles, Doubles and Trios events.
- 27. Ranking Points will only be awarded to those who bowl in all three main events, i.e. Singles, Doubles and Trios (there are no ranking points for the Mixed Doubles).
- 28. Special consideration will be given to bowlers, in extenuating circumstances, who cannot compete in all the events (e.g. due to hospitalisation, injury, bereavement).
- 29. The Tournament Committee will permit no unreasonable delay in the progress of any game. Should a competitor refuse to proceed with a shot/game after being directed to do so, that game will be forfeited.
- 30. Bowlers must comply with instructions issued by Lane Marshalls (Tournament Manager). Failure to comply may result in disqualification.
- 31. All bowlers/Captain must sign the official score sheets on completion of each squad; unsigned score sheets may result in the loss of these scores.
- 32. The use of talcum powder, open rosin bags/grips sacs, or similar substances, presents a serious hazard and will not be permitted in the bowling area, on approaches / shoes.
- 33. Any individual whose conduct is derogatory or not to be in the best interest of the sport, on or off the lanes, during the entire period of the Championships may be disqualified from the tournament and will be reported to the National Governing Body.
- 34. The consumption of food or drink will not be permitted in the bowlers' area.





## General Strategy - Kegel Beaten Path (41' / 50 mL)

Pattern Specs (Updated):

Length: 41 feet

Volume: 50 mL (Heavy for this length)

Ratio: 4.04:1 (Sport-level but moderately forgiving)

Shape: Tapered toward outside—guides you to "beaten path"

#### Lane Play - Angles & Target Zones

#### Early (Fresh) - Hold in the middle, playable outside

Ideal Line: Arrows 12–14 → exit point 10

· Stay between 2nd and 3rd arrows, targeting the track area

• 4:1 allows a bit of miss-room in, but not much miss right

Shot shape: Slight belly, controlled arc (not skid-flip)

#### Mid Block - Transition

- Move 2-3 boards inside with your feet, 1-2 boards with eyes
- Target: Arrows 15–17 → Breakpoint 8–10
- Watch for early hook in the track, may need to smooth out surface or change to cleaner ball

#### Late (Breakdown)

- Moving in deep: Arrows 18–22 → Breakpoint 10–13
- Use cleaner covers and strong backend motion
- Rev-dominant players can open up more; speed-dominant players should stay straighter

#### **Ball Selection by Phase**

Phase	Ball Type	Cover / Surface	Notes
Fresh	Symmetrical solid	2000–3000 grit	Read midlane, control shape
Transition	Hybrid / Medium pearl	Factory or light polish	Maintain shape, avoid over-read
Late	Pearl asymmetric / Strong pearl	Polished or shiny box finish	Energy retention, backend motion

#### Top Ball Examples:

- Fresh: Storm Phaze II, Motiv Jackal Ambush, Hammer Black Widow 2.0
- Transition: Roto Grip TNT Infused, Motiv Supra Rally, Storm Hy-Road
- Late: 900 Global Zen, Track Stealth Pearl, Storm Fate

## **Breakpoint Targeting**

With 4.04:1, your breakpoint can shift wider than on flatter sport patterns. General guidance:

- Breakpoint zone: 6-10 just beyond 41 feet
- · You want your ball to enter the friction outside without over-skidding or jumping

## **Key Adjustments**

Lane Read	What's Happening	Your Move
Hooks too early	Track is burning	Move left, ball down, add speed
Doesn't hook	Too much oil middle	Add surface, slow speed, move right
Leaving splits	Over/under reaction	Soften angles, use smoother ball motion

## Tips for Success on 4.04:1 Beaten Path

- Play within the pattern—avoid extremes until the lane forces you
- Manage your transition—don't chase too deep too fast
- Surface prep matters—match ball surface to volume and your rev rate
- Spare shooting is crucial—the flatter ratio means more corner pin leaves




