To be eligible to bowl in the monthly tournaments, all bowlers must be aged 49 years or older and have a current TI Membership Card.

You MUST play in a <u>minimum of 6</u> of the 10 Monthly Ranked Events to be eligible to qualify for the end of season Senior Grand Prix Finals while the <u>best 7 of 10 Ranked Events Points overall will count for rankings</u>.

(Grand Prix Qualifiers: Gents - 8 Scratch & 8 Handicap / Ladies - 4 Scratch & 4 Handicap)

NOTE: FOR NEW MEMBERS, MEMBERSHIP FORM AND AFFILIATION FEES FOR PERIOD TO 30^{TH} SEPT 2025 MUST BE COMPLETED AND RETURNED PRIOR TO PARTICIPATION IN THIS RANKING EVENT. (CURRENT MEMBERSHIPS FOR 2024/2025 EXPIRE ON THE 30^{TH} SEPTEMBER 2025 AND NEW FORMS AND FEES PAYABLE AT/OR BEFORE THE NEXT EVENT ON THE 5^{TH} OCTOBER 2025 FOR THE 2025/2026 SEASON)

Dress Code

The following dress code applies: TI Senior Ranking Tournament Dress Code (2025/2026)

- 1. **Shirts** Must be a polo or dye sublimated bowling shirt affiliated with the Tenpin Bowling Industry. Logos must not compromise the Association's integrity.
- 2. **Bottoms** Plain-coloured dress slacks, tracksuit bottoms, sports leggings, tailored golf shorts, skirts, or skorts. Skirts, skorts, and shorts must be below fingertip length and provide full coverage.
- 3. **Prohibited Items** Denim, jeans, combats, sleeveless shirts, T-shirts, large studded belts, straps, buckles, and street shoes.
- 4. **Enforcement** Senior Sub-committee has final say. Non-compliance results in **zero ranking points** for that event. Applies to all official training sessions and affiliated events.

Kev Reminders (2025/2026)

- 1. **Selection Criteria & Handbook** Available on the TI website.
- 2. **Event Finals** At the end of season meeting it was agreed that there will be no event finals.
- 3. **Equipment** Balance holes in bowling balls are no longer permitted. Ensure your ball is correctly prepared before the event.
- 4. **During Tournament Play:**
 - 1) Mobile phones must be set on **SILENT** and
 - 2) NO coaching in the bowlers' area during tournament play.
- 5. **As a courtesy to bowlers who are not yet finished** please **DO NOT MOVE LANES after finishing** your game until ALL players are finished theirs.
- 6. **Smoking Regulations** Smoking and vaping are **NOT ALLOWED** during the tournament (as per TI, EBF and IBF rules).

Anti-Doping

ALL bowlers must comply with Irish Anti-Doping Rules and with the World Anti-Doping Code (WADA 2021 code)

All Bowlers have signed a TI Membership Form agreeing to be bound by the:

- i. Association's rules and accept that this may include Anti-Doping tests carried out by Sport Ireland.
- ii. Members' Code of Ethics and social media Policy both of which will be updated from time to time in line with the requirements and development of the Association.
- iii. Acknowledge that they have read, understand and accept the General Code of Conduct (the Code) and agree to be bound by the Code while participating or attending the sport in any capacity.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN LOSS OF GRAND PRIX AND RANKING POINTS AND POSSIBLE DISQUALIFICATION
