Junior Event Number 1 - Silver Level Event - Season 2025/2026

Check-in: 09:30am **Bowling at:** 10:00am (sharp)

Qualification Round: Bowlers will play 6 Games moving one pair of lanes to the right after

each game.

Finals: The 'Top 3' bowlers in the relevant categories will play a knockout round where the bowlers will play one game with the lowest score being eliminated. The remaining 2 bowlers will play one further game to determine 1st and 2nd place.

Categories: Mixed – Age 18 & Under; Boys Age 15 & Under; and Girls Age 15 & Under

Mixed Categories: Girls will receive a 10-pin handicap.

Entry Fee: €30

Oil Pattern: Lithium (44ft)

To be eligible to bowl in the monthly junior tournaments, all bowlers <u>must be current junior members of Tenpin</u> Ireland.

How to enter: Applications will be accepted through email only. Applications will be accepted until 6pm on Friday, 26th September 2025. Applications must be sent to juniors@tenpinbowling.ie and include the full name of your child or children taking part and the relevant age group they are competing in (Age 15 & Under or Age 18 & Under).

International Tournament Qualification

Junior Triple Crown 2026 ("JTC"): Ranking points will be awarded, subject to the junior eligibility criteria, based on the final position of each bowler within their designated age category. The current age categories for JTC are 'Age 15 & Under' and 'Age 18 & Under'.

European Youth Championships 2026 ("EYC"): Tournament averages will be used to determine eligibility for EYC panel selection. Qualifying averages are: Boys – 180 Average and Girls – 170 Average. Qualifying age group 'Under 18'.

As these events are ranking tournaments, the following dress code and rules apply:

- Girls must wear plain-coloured skorts or skirts or black slacks or trousers or black sport leggings.
- Boys must wear plain-black slacks / trousers.
- Shorts, sheer leggings, sleeveless tops, tee shirts and V-neck tee shirts are amongst the clothing items **not permitted**.
- Athlete must wear a bowling shirt whether it be a polo or dye sublimated, the definition of this is a shirt directly affiliated within the Tenpin Bowling Industry. Please note it is **no longer a requirement** for bowlers to have their full

name or surname clearly visible in either print or embroidery on the back of a collared shirt or sports shirt. The bowling shirt must not contain any logos which compromise the integrity of the Association.

- All bowlers must check-in before going on the lanes.
- Mobile phones are not permitted once you register for tournaments and must be switched off during play.
- The use of earphones, unless medically prescribed, is not permitted during Junior tournaments.
- All bowlers are expected to comply with the members Code of Ethics, Social Media Policy and Anti-doping rules all of which are available online www.tenpinbowling.ie

All bowler must comply with Irish Anti-Doping Rules and with the World Anti-Doping Code. (WADA 2021 code)

Failure to comply with the Dress Code and/or Rules may result in disqualification, loss of ranking points and loss of eligibility for selection. Serious breaches of the Code of Ethics or Social Media Policy may result in loss of eligibility for selection and withdrawal of ITBA membership.
