



Tournament Rules

(EBF Championship Rules Apply)

1. Governance and Eligibility

1. The Tournament is sanctioned by Tenpin Ireland (TI) and conducted in accordance with EBF Championship Rules and TI General Playing Rules.
2. All participants must be aged 49 or over and hold current Tenpin Ireland membership. Membership may be verified at registration.
3. All competitors must comply with **Sport Ireland / WADA Anti-Doping Regulations** throughout the event.

2. Dress Code

4. Athletes must wear a **recognised bowling shirt** (collared polo or dye-sublimated) affiliated with the tenpin bowling industry.
 - Shirts must not display logos that compromise the integrity or reputation of Tenpin Ireland.
 - Display of a player's name on the shirt is optional.
5. Permitted lower garments include plain-coloured dress slacks, tracksuit bottoms, sports leggings, tailored golf shorts, skirts or skorts.
 - Shorts, skirts, and skorts must extend below the fingertips when standing and must provide appropriate coverage at all times.

3. Equipment and Ball Regulations

6. It is the responsibility of each bowler to ensure that all bowling balls comply with the **current USBC Approved Bowling Ball List**, including specifications for weight, balance, and hardness.
7. A maximum of **six (6) bowling balls** may be registered per athlete prior to the start of the Tournament.
 - Ball registration will close immediately following Official Practice prior to the Mixed Doubles.
 - No additions or replacements are permitted once the first event has commenced, Mixed Doubles, except in exceptional circumstances approved by the Tournament Manager.
8. Random equipment checks may be carried out at any time during competition at the discretion of the Tournament Manager.

4. Ball Surface Adjustments

9. Surface adjustments using approved cleaners, polish, pads, or scrub sponges may only be carried out:
 - During official practice sessions; or
 - Between blocks of games, semi-finals, or finals, and outside the athletes' area.
10. Abrasive surface changes using bonded or coated abrasives are permitted only in designated areas and only during practice or between competition blocks.

5. Registration, Play, and Conduct

11. Registration will close 10 minutes before the scheduled start time. Late arrivals will not be permitted to bowl or transfer squads.
12. Bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their turn. One-lane courtesy applies on both sides.
 - Slow play constitutes poor sportsmanship and may result in disciplinary action.
13. Mobile phones must be switched to **silent mode** during play.
14. Coaching is **not permitted** during tournament play.

6. Protests, Disputes, and Discipline

15. A provisional ball must be rolled in any dispute that cannot be resolved immediately.
16. All protests or complaints must be submitted **in writing within 30 minutes** of the completion of the squad in which the issue occurred.
17. Any competitor whose conduct is deemed unsporting, derogatory, or contrary to the Code of Conduct or best interests of the sport may be disqualified and reported to Tenpin Ireland.

7. Anti-Doping, Alcohol, and Smoking

18. Competitors are strictly prohibited from smoking, vaping, or consuming alcohol during any part of the competition.
 - Breaches may result in disqualification.

8. Tournament Committee

19. The Tournament Committee for this event shall consist of:
Adrienne Dunne (Manager), Áine Lebioda, Ray Bergin, Paul McCauley, Mark Higson, Stephen Ekermans, and David Seay.
20. The decisions of the Tournament Committee and Tournament Managers on all matters are final and binding.

9. Competition Format and Awards

21. This Tournament includes Scratch and Handicap divisions.
22. Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in both Scratch and Handicap sections.
23. Scratch medals will be awarded first; Handicap medals will be awarded from the remaining eligible competitors.
24. A scratch score may place in the Handicap section if it exceeds competing handicap scores.
25. High Game awards, Men and Ladies, will be presented including Mixed Doubles.
26. Memorial trophies will be awarded as follows:
 - Bernard Groves Memorial Trophy – top male and female handicap bowler not qualifying for Scratch Masters.
 - Elspeth Gailey Memorial Trophy – Ladies Scratch Singles winner.
 - Larry O'Leary Memorial Trophy – Men's Scratch Singles winner.

10. Ranking Points and Ties

27. Ranking Points will be awarded based on current **Double-points** for scratch pinfall from Singles, Doubles, and Trios events.
28. Ranking Points will only be awarded to bowlers who compete in all three main events.
29. In the event of a tie, the **highest last scratch game** will determine the final placing.

11. Exceptional Circumstances

30. The Tournament Committee may, at its discretion, grant special consideration in cases of injury, hospitalisation, or bereavement preventing full participation.
