TOURNAMENT RULES

The tournament is re-entry and sanctioned by the I.T.B.A. and their general playing and tournament rules will govern this tournament together with the following rules:

- All bowlers must be current members of their National Bowling Association and must present a current membership card when registering at the tournament. All squads are mixed age groups. Please indicate on entry form your preferred squad and age group you are participating in.
- Category 1: 0-14 (born after 30 June 2012)
 Category 2/3: 15-18 (born after 30 June 2018)
 Category 4: 19-25 (born after 30 June 2000)
- Bowlers must sign the official scoresheet unsigned sheets will not be accepted and the games will not be added to the running total.
- A provisional ball shall be rolled in the case of a dispute which cannot be settled on the spot.
- Bowling balls must conform with I.T.B.A. specifications for weight hardness and balance. Use of chemicals, solvents or other methods to alter the surface of a ball are prohibited.
- Only Competitors and official Coaches and Officials allowed in bowling area.
- Any individual whose conduct is considered to be derogatory to the best interest of the sport on or off the lanes, during the Tournament will be reported to their National Association and may be disqualified from the rest of the Tournament. Any Bowler found to be under the influence of alcohol will be disqualified from the Tournament.
- The Tournament Manager will allow no unreasonable delay in the progress of any game. Should a bowler refuse to proceed with a game after being directed to do so by the Tournament Manager, such game shall be deemed void. The Tournament Manager has the right to re-rate, reject, reschedule any entry in the interest of the tournament.
- Entries will only be accepted with Entry Fee and will be on a first come first served basis.
- The Tournament Manager will be Sean Kennedy and his decisions on all matters will be final.

FORMAT

QUALIFICATION: Entries and Re-entries 6 Games
 Highest series will count for qualification.
CATEGORY 4 is combined Girls & Boys.
 Girls will receive 8 pins per game.
FORMAT ROUND 1: All Bowlers will play 6 games.
ROUND 2: The Top 16 Category 4 will play a further 3 games (Pinfall carried forward).
ROUND 3: The Top 4 will contest a 3 game Round Robin.
ROUND 1: Bowlers in Categories 1,2,3 will play 6 games (Pinfall carried forward). Girls in Category 1 receive 8 pins per game.
ROUND 2: Top 16 boys, top 16 Girls Category 2,3 will play a further 3 games, after which the field will be cut to four (pinfall carried forward). Top 16 in Category 1 play a further three games, after which the field will be cut to four.
ROUND 3: The top 4 bowlers in each Category will contest a three game Round-Robin.
TIES: In the event of a tie for 16th or 4th places the highest last game will decide. If this results in a further tie, the highest penultimate game will decide.
PROTESTS: All protests must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Manager within thirty minutes of the game in which the infraction occurred.
ILLEGAL PINFALL: Pins which are knocked down by anything other than a legally delivered ball, or the resulting pin action, must in all cases be respotted as such pinfall is illegal.
REGISTRATION: All competitors must register at least thirty minutes prior to their scheduled bowling time. Tardy players will be replaced by the next reserve.
